**Proyecto de Tema Uno--Mis Amigos y Yo: Álbum de Recuerdos**

**Overview:** You will create two pages for a scrapbook featuring photos of you and your friends with captions written in Spanish underneath. Then you will give an oral presentation of your scrapbook, describing the people in the photos and telling what they like and they don't like to do.

**Materials:** Construction paper (provided) or scrapbooking paper (provided by students); photographs or pictures from magazines; stickers if desired.

**Process:**

1. Draw a rough sketch of your scrapbook pages.
2. Get input from a class mate. Make sure they make notes directly on your sketch and sign it.
3. Write a draft of your captions.
4. Have 2 class mates peer edit. Make sure they make notes directly on your draft, that they use the minimums and rubric to check your work, and that they sign their notes.
5. Write/ type out your captions and layout your final draft of the scrap book pages.
6. GLUE everything down.
7. Practice your presentation with a classmate.
8. Present your completed pages to the class describing the photos and telling what they like and don't like to do.

**Minimum requirements (2 points each):**

1.	Two pages.
2.	Three photos/ pictures.
3.	At least six people described.
4.	Captions should contain people's names, a description of each and one thing they each like to do.
5.	Pages are decorated/ illustrated.
