



Course Description-

This one semester elective class is available to eligible 11th and 12th graders. Students selected for this class will leave campus for approximately 4 hours per week to participate in this supervised internship at an appropriate location. Students must provide their own transportation.

Students will be selected based on the following criteria and suitable position availability:

A student must have a 2.5 un-weighted GPA. The student does not have to be college bound.

He/she must submit names of two teachers for a recommendation based on maturity, responsibility and effort in class. Remember: The student will be representing the school to an outside organization.

The student must show a sincere interest in the area they wish to pursue.

The process will be as follows:

The student will submit 3 interest levels for possible intern placement.

The supervisor will approve the student and pass that on to the high school assistant principal and the guidance department.

The student will then be cleared to register for the course.

The supervisors and the student will work on an individual suitable placement.

The supervisors will arrange placement at the site.

The student will meet with the school supervisors once a week.

Other work will be required of the students by the school supervisors.

Grading will be based on evaluation by both the site and school supervisors.
